Some data



Nearly 1 child or adolescent of every 2 identified as meeting criteria for:

- * Disruptive disorder (27%)
- * Conduct disorder (12%)
- **Oppositional defiant disorder (12%)
- * Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (estimated 11%)
- *Anxiety and depressive disorders (18% and 11%) and PTSD (4%)

Causes

Genetic factors

- Temperament
- Perfectionism
- Antenatal Environment

Environmental Factors

- Parental Socialization
- Absence of family structure/support
- High Expectations
- Poor Coping Skills


Emotion Socialization

Regulated Parenting

- Emotionally available and regulated
- Connected with your students- while setting limits
- Coach / model & support mastery instead of threaten and control
 - Empathic limits (connected while setting limits) instead of punishment
